

Lee Terrace Blackheath

Our design for the mixed-use development will replace the existing BMW garage with a high quality development comprising of 20 apartments over the retained BMW boutique Showroom and 10 townhouses. The site is prominent and architecturally sensitive, located at the heart of the Blackheath conservation area in an area of well-preserved regency architecture and immediately adjacent to a listed Old St Margaret's churchyard.
